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Considerations for Community Involvement

Welcoming and Integration – Create a strong first impression, form a community support committee and maintain a friendly relationship with the practitioner and their family.

Understanding Practitioner/Family Needs – Get to know the practitioner and their family to learn the best ways to support their needs, such as locating housing, accessing childcare services, partner/spousal employment opportunities or other.

Embrace Diversity – Support the practitioner to create cultural connections and encourage an inclusive environment for diverse backgrounds.

Demonstrate Appreciation – Show appreciation by sending thank you cards, organizing appreciation events or providing recreation passes.
